To: Junior Livestock Exhibitors

It is time to start choosing market animals (steer, hog, lamb and goat) for the 2024 White County Fair. The number of market animals that can be nominated are the same as last year. The number of market animals that can be brought to the fair will also be the same. The following is the number of market animals that can be nominated and shown:

Steers must be in possession of the exhibitor by April 1, 2024 and the exhibitor must call in by April 1st to the beef superintendent, Ouida Cossey, with your name, address, and telephone number.

Market hogs, lambs and goats must be in possession of the exhibitor by July 1st and be reported to their respective superintendent by July 1st.

There will be a **\$10 nomination fee** for each steer, hog, lamb and goat nominated. The nomination fee should be mailed to the **White County Fair Association, Post Office Box 1605, Searcy, AR 72145**. A drop box will also be available at the fair office on the fairgrounds, if you prefer to drop off your nomination fee. **Be sure to note who the nomination fee is for when mailing or dropping off.**

ALL MARKET ANIMALS WILL BE REQUIRED TO REGISTER ONLINE BY AUGUST 1ST. Online entries will be available July 1, 2024 – August 1, 2024. Online entries will be made at www.fairentry.com.

All animals nominated as a wether or barrow must be banded or cut before arrival for processing.

All market goats and lambs must have scrapie tag IN THE EAR or registration tattoo with papers.

The junior market animal show and sale is available to all White County youth following their 9th birthday through their 19th birthday or one time following graduation of high school. Any youth living or attending school, in White County may exhibit and compete for prize money. If you have questions, please call the respective superintendent. I look forward to working with you this coming Fair year.
